



2009 U.S. Open Championship Bethpage State Park – Black Course

Farmingdale, New York

June 15 – 21, 2009



Bethpage is regarded as the largest public golf facility in the world and hosted the first U.S. Open played on a truly public course.

In 2002, Bethpage State Park’s Black Course made history as the first truly public course to host the U.S. Open.

Tiger Woods won his second U.S. Open title in front of the most animated crowd in U.S. Open history. Following the unprecedented success and excitement of the 2002 Championship, the U.S. Open will return to Bethpage for an encore performance in 2009, making it the third time in nine years that a municipal course plays host to the U.S. Open. Bethpage State Park, set on 1,476 acres of

undulating Long Island terrain, was built at the time of the New Deal and motivated by the progressive vision of then New York City Parks Commissioner Robert Moses. Designed by architect A. W. Tillinghast (whose other works include Baltusrol and Winged Foot), Bethpage’s collection of five golf courses is regarded as the largest public golf facility in the world. Both accessible to the public and tremendously challenging, Bethpage allows a new generation to enjoy the game. A sign near the first tee reads “Warning: The Black Course is an extremely difficult course which we recommend only for highly skilled golfers.” Tillinghast’s strategic design, coupled with the course’s seemingly indomitable length, has already proven to be a severe test for the world’s best golfers. In 2009, the demanding course will converge once again with the vigorous New York crowd to make the U.S. Open the “People’s Open.”
