Mobile Device Policy

The USGA encourages fans to capture their favorite moments at our championships and stay connected with family and friends while on site. We have set guidelines on mobile device usage to ensure our players and other fans are not distracted or disrupted during the championship. Fans may carm pobile devices smaller than 7" in length and/or height; however, please make sure all device volume controls are set to "silent" or "vibrate" and flash photography is disabled prior to entering the championship gate. "Fan Zones" have been designated throughout the championship site for fans to place or receive calls. Phone calls must not be received or placed in any area that may disrupt play including grandstands. Photography, video, and audio recording are permitted throughout the course, but content must not be used for commercial purposes. Live streaming or shot-by-shot coverage of any player (with or without video) is not permitted at any time throughout championship week.
