

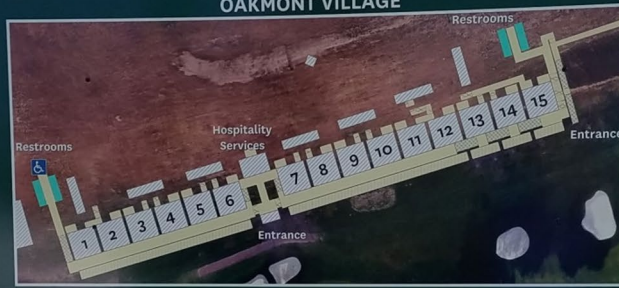
Village Map
